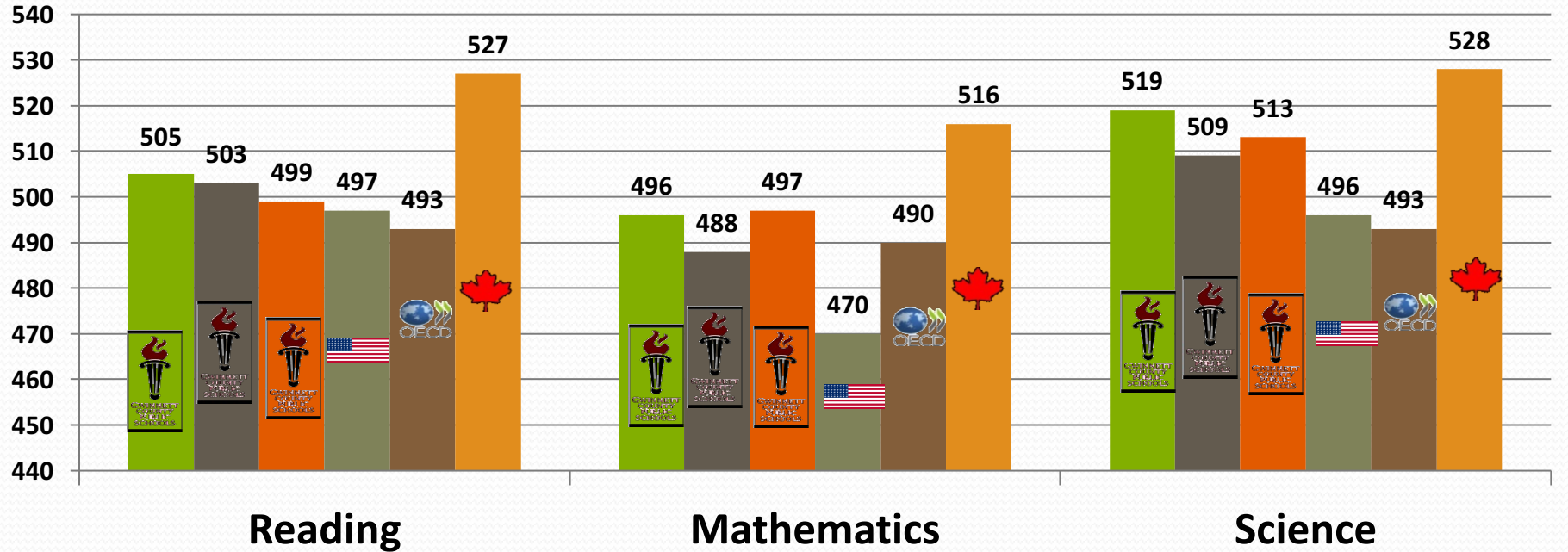

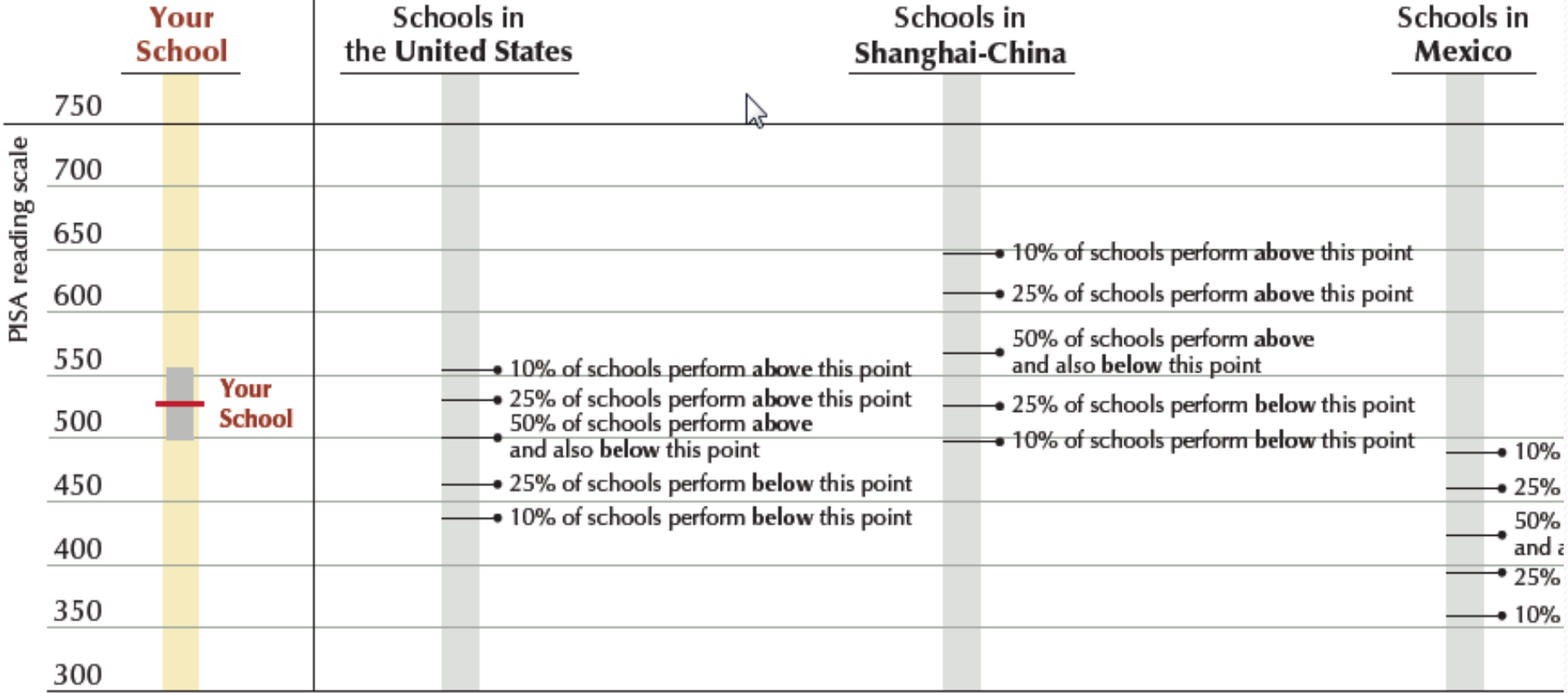


Figure 4.1 ■ How your school's results in reading compare with schools in the United States in PISA 2012



● Your School ○ Schools in the United States that participated in PISA 2012

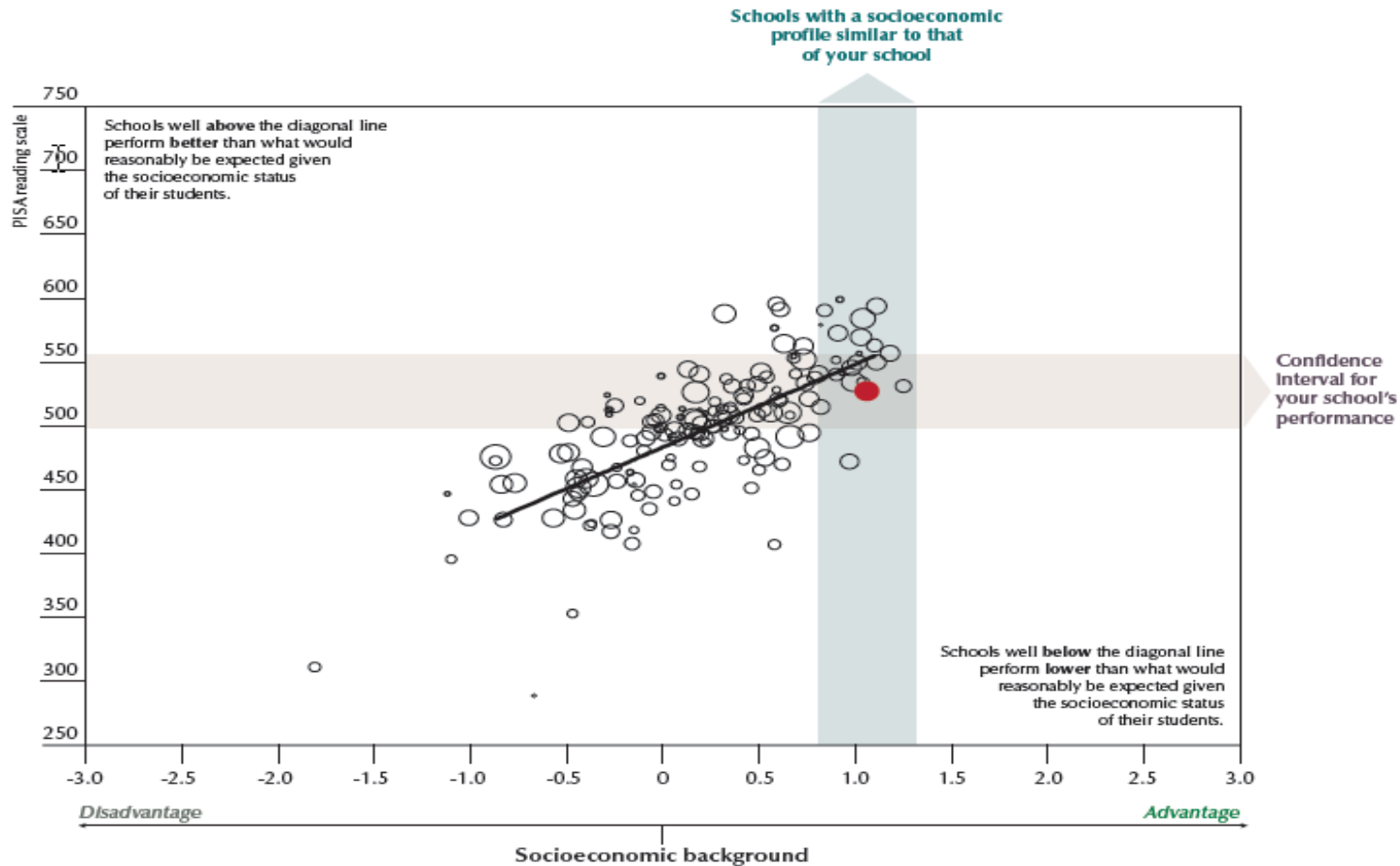


Figure 4.1 ■ How your school's results in reading compare with schools in the United States in PISA 2012

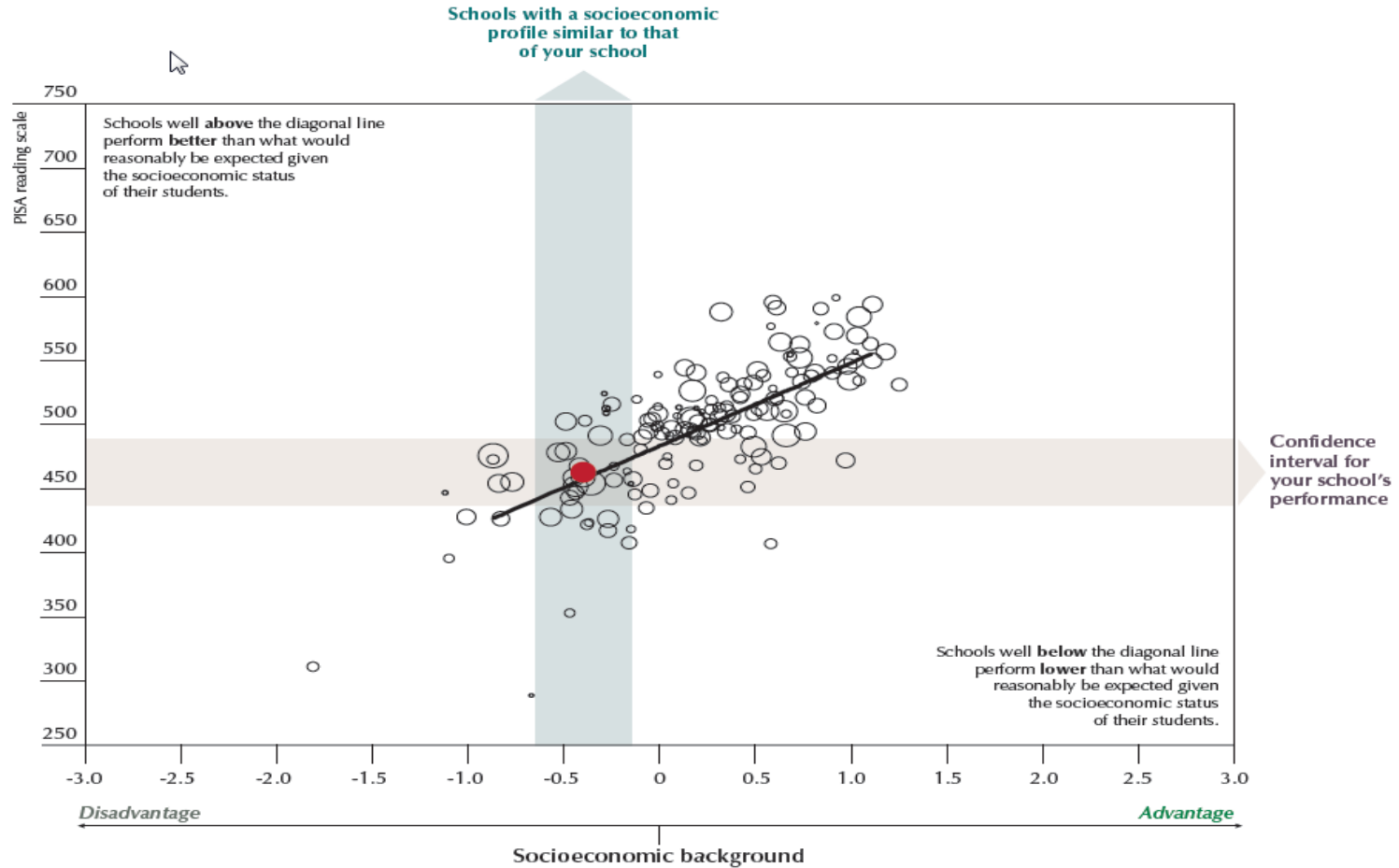
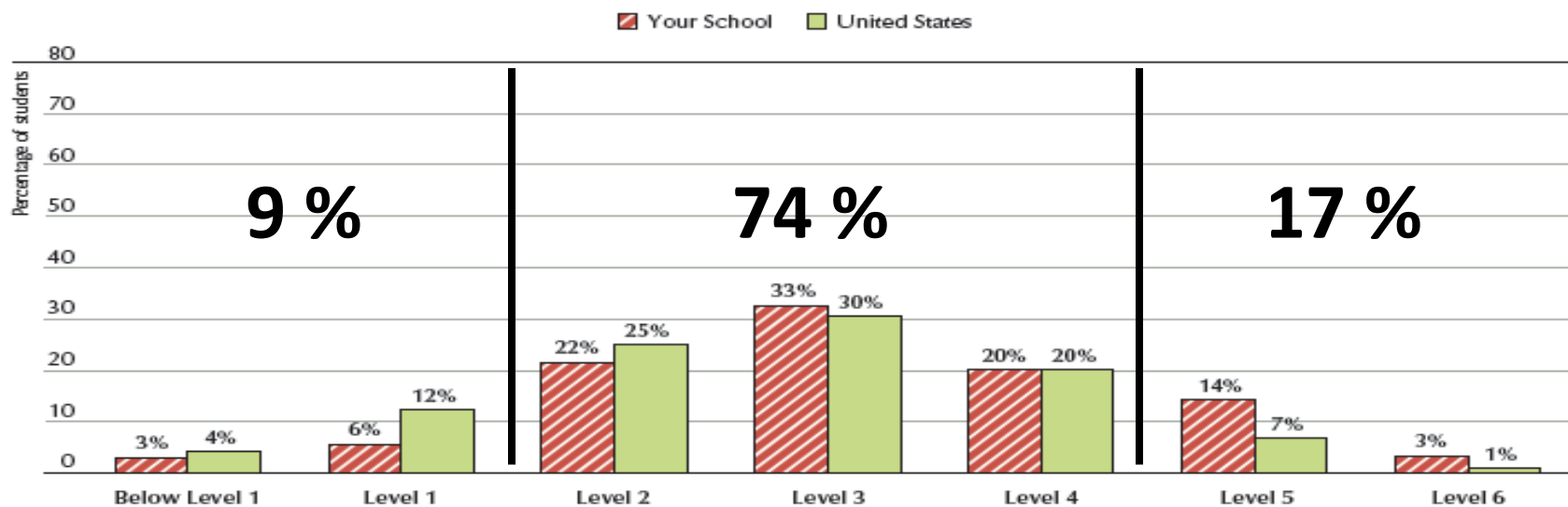

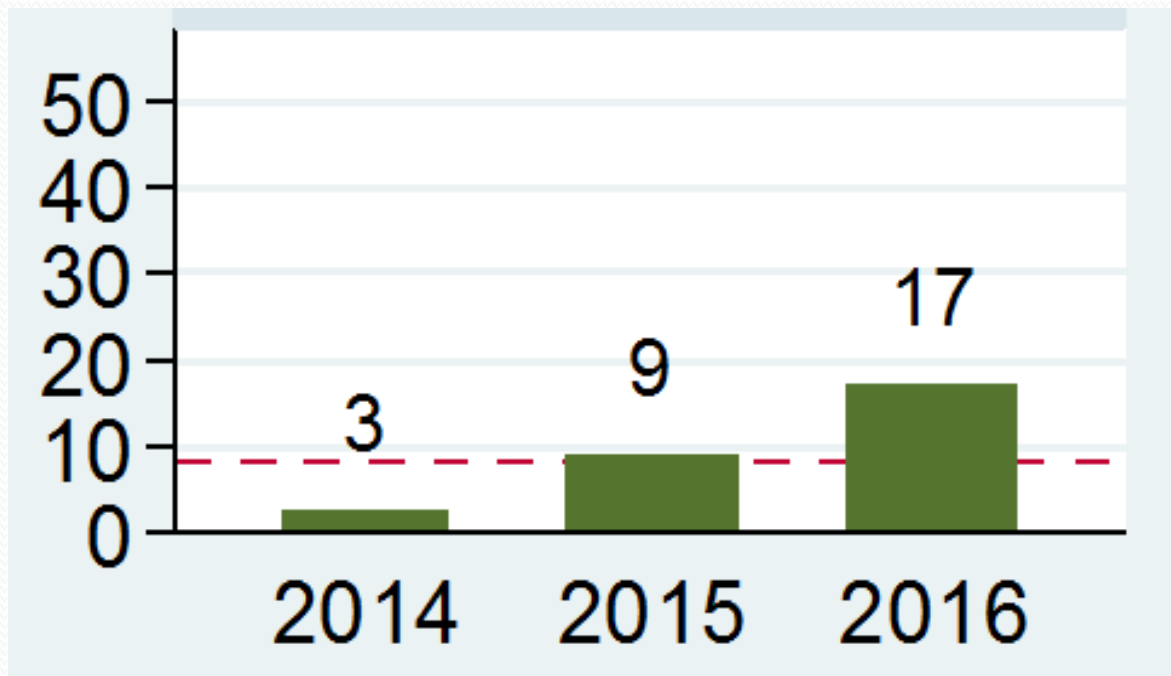
