This is how we introduced it to our students this year...

- We all play a part in how our students decide to utilize their time

NEST Statistics

- Only 20 students in our building never attended (logged) a NEST session.
- 927 Students attended one NEST session/week over the year.
- 1260 Students visited the media center; 1055 computer labs; 355 writing labs
- Over 2,000 sessions of AP course support attended
- Over 7,100 tutoring sessions attended last year.

You can lead a horse to water...

- Some of our students did not utilize NEST time as well as they could have
- We identified a large number of students who had D's or F's in classes and were in danger of failing for the year
- They were assigned a “mandatory NEST schedule” customized for their needs
