
# The L!BRARY

Book documents an initiative by the Robin Hood Foundation and New York City elementary schools to re-imagine the school library by asking new questions about one of the only places in the school that all the students visit. What if you made reading a pivotal life experience for children challenged by poverty? What does design collaboration look like? What is a library? What would you say if your words wallpapered the room? How do you revolutionize an element of society as fundamental as children's education? How does it feel to hide in a corner with a good book? What are the new paradigms for public-school instruction, community development, and architectural design serving the common good? How can architects, artists, philanthropists, publishers, manufacturers, librarians, principals, teachers, students, and their families partner to make a schoolroom dynamic? How do children learn? How do librarians teach? What ingredients make a good idea?



## Cave Space

**Places for individual study, reflection, quiet reading and creative flow are rare in school.**




It is true that most schools have libraries to encourage reading and independent study, but the problem with libraries is that they are mostly set up according to an adult's view of what a quiet place should be. The very rules that keep a library quiet sometimes make it oppressive for students. Schools need to explore other areas that can serve as Cave Spaces.

2. **How can librarians and libraries become more Future Ready?**




