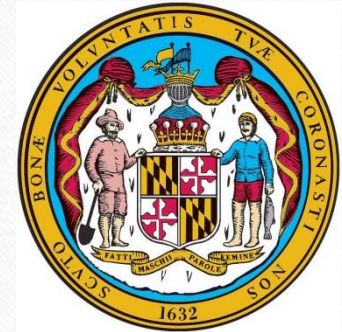

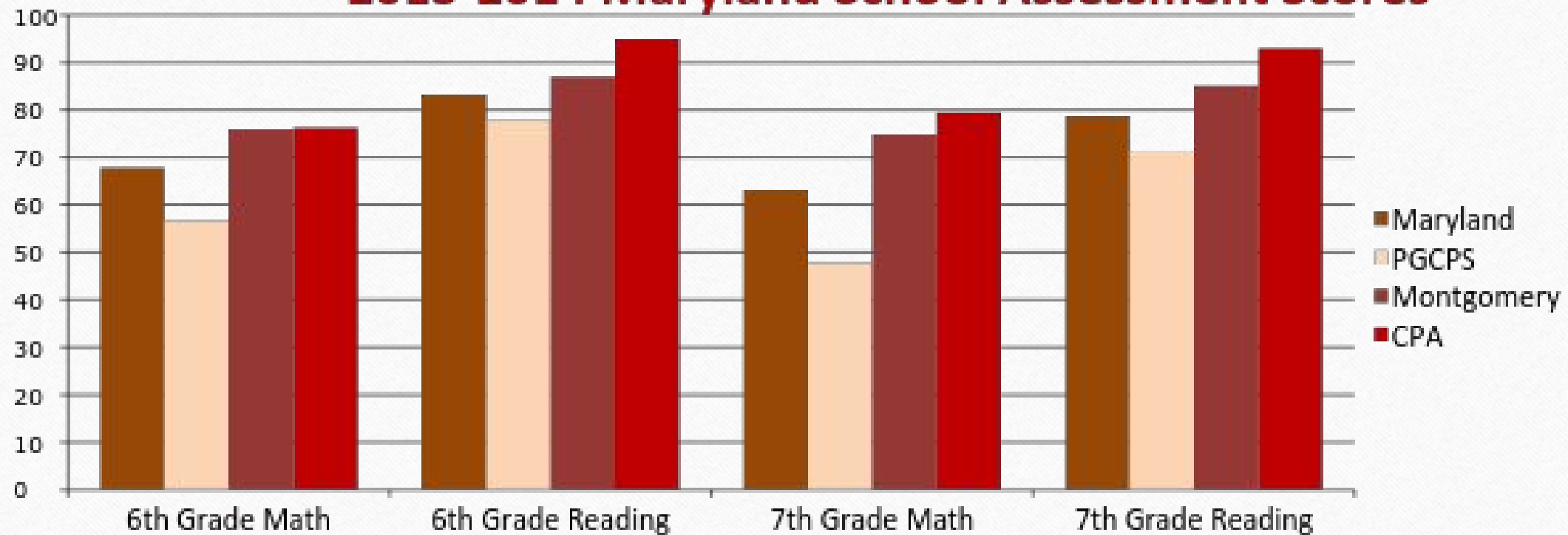

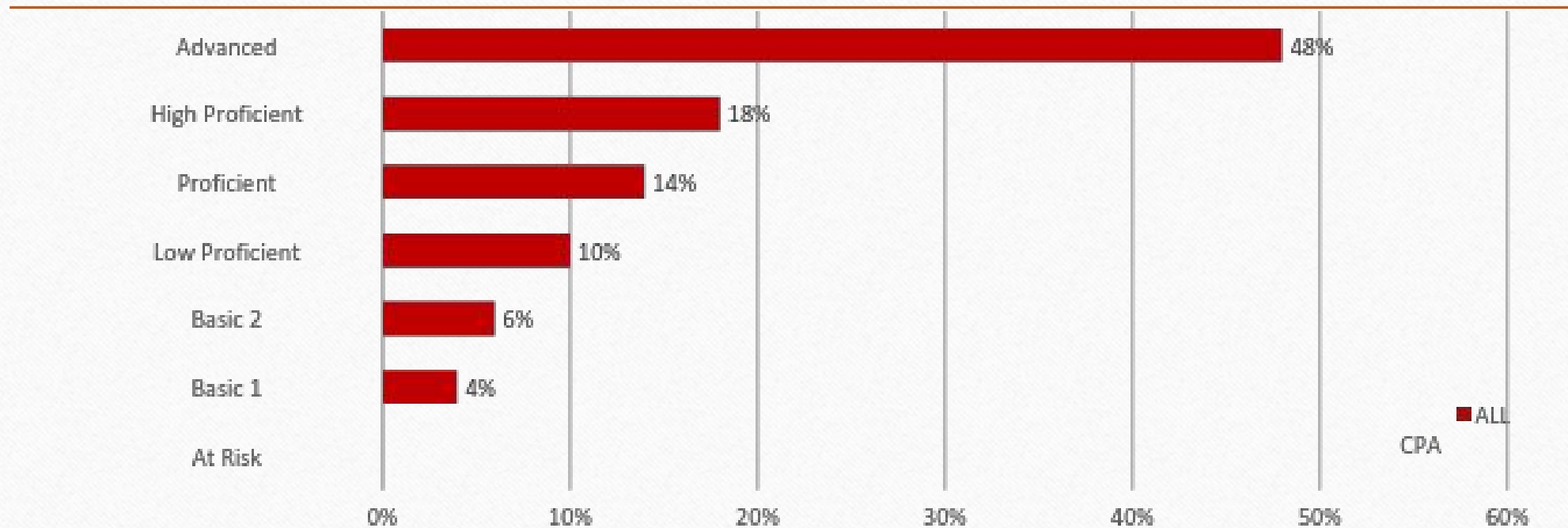

2013-2014 Maryland School Assessment Scores



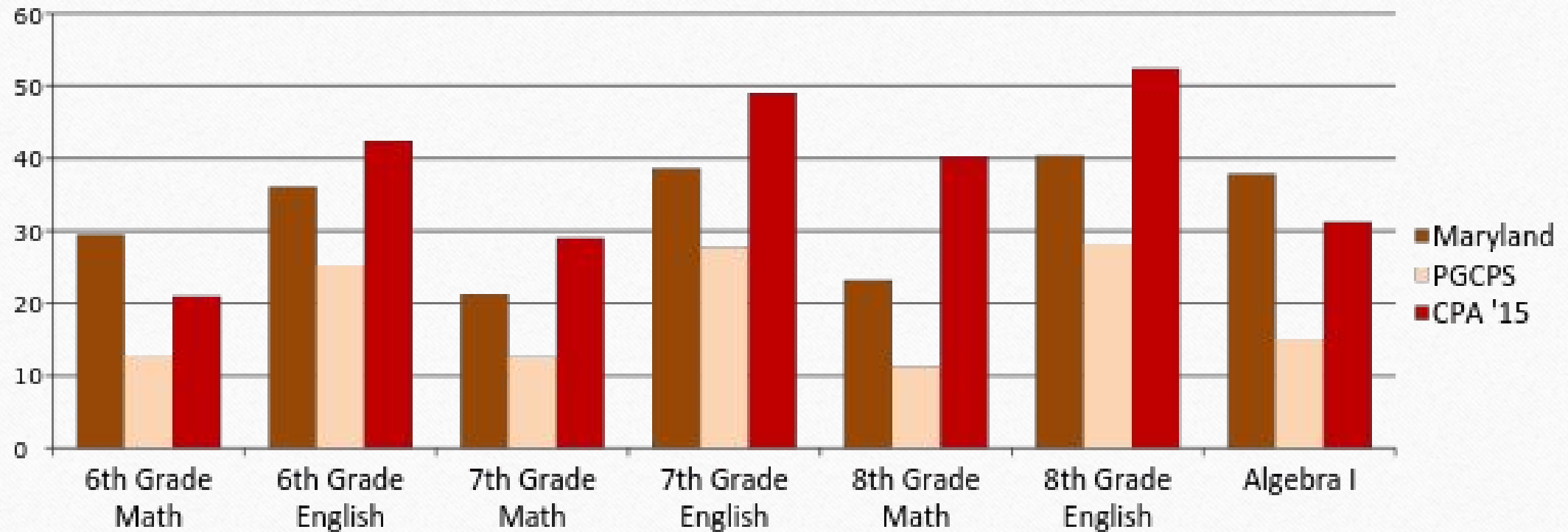
Spring Scholastic Reading Inventory 2014-2015



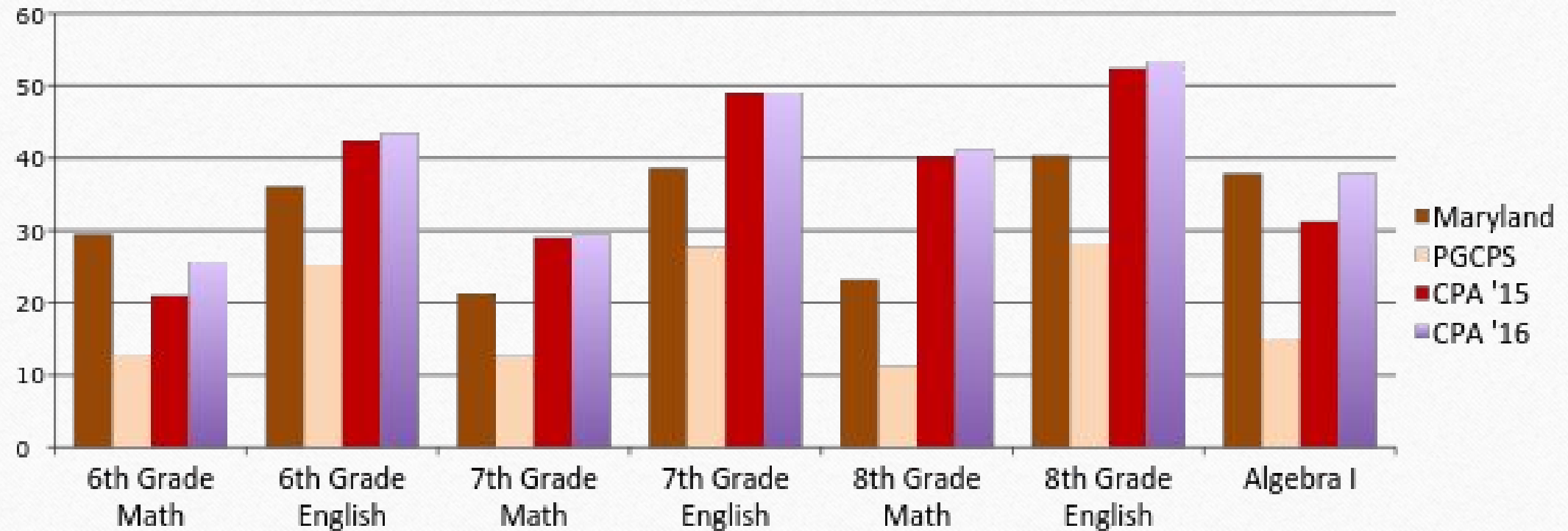
