



Librarians: Digital Citizenship Champions!



American Association of School Librarians (2011)

Survey data from the American Library Association shows that 70% of digital citizenship instruction is happening in the school library program, and 52% of the instruction is being delivered by the school librarian in isolation from other adults in the school

A 2019 statewide survey in Utah shows that:

- 47% of digcit *planning* is owned by the school librarian
- 59.9% of respondents believe the librarian should be responsible for planning digcit education in some capacity
- 69.9% believe the librarian should be responsible for teaching digcit either alone or in collaboration with teachers.
