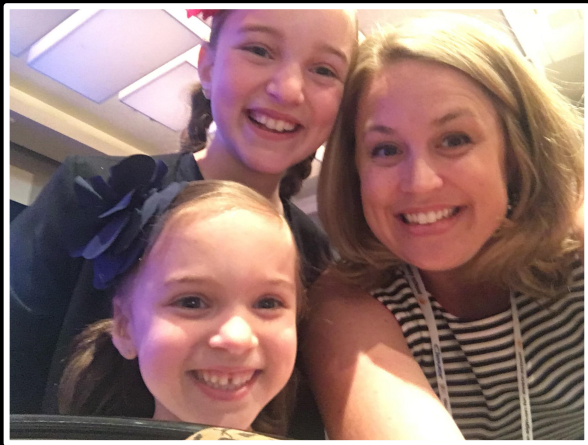

### LITERACY

#### Inspires and supports the reading lives of both students and teachers

Creates inclusive collections that acknowledge and celebrate diverse experiences and provide instructional opportunities to empower learners as effective users and creators of information and ideas.

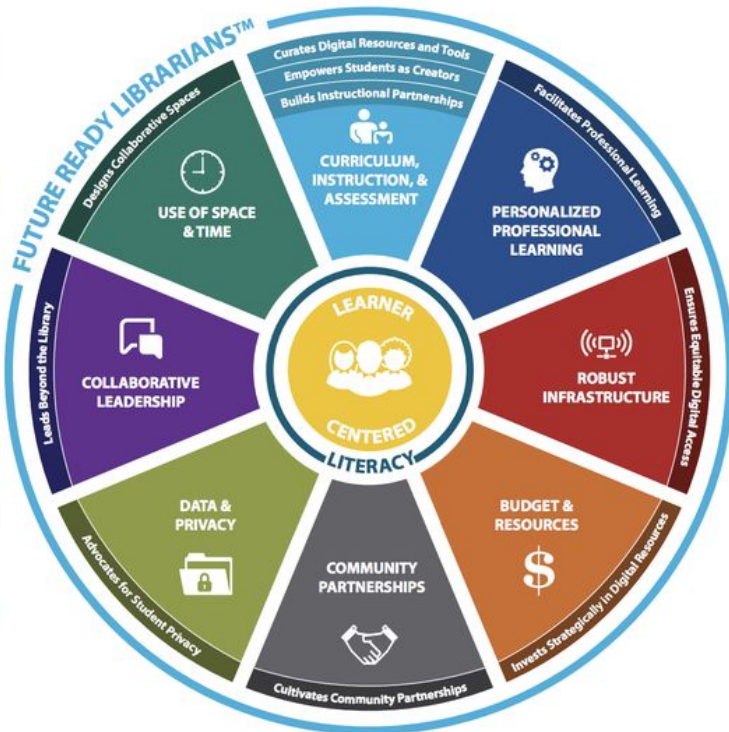

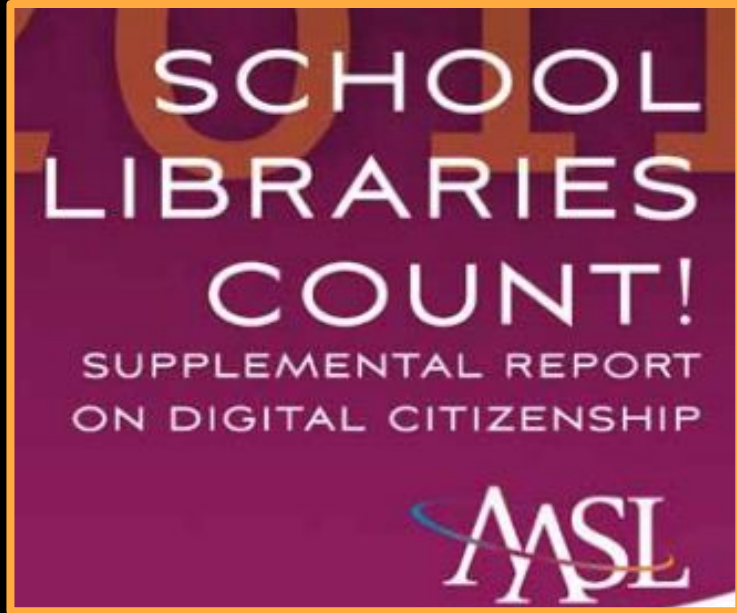

# Librarians: Digital Citizenship Champions!



American Association of School Librarians (2011)

Survey data from the American Library Association shows that 70% of digital citizenship instruction is happening in the school library program, and 52% of the instruction is being delivered by the school librarian in isolation from other adults in the school

# A 2019 statewide survey in Utah shows that:

- 47% of digcit *planning* is owned by the school librarian
- 59.9% of respondents believe the librarian *should be responsible for planning* digcit education in some capacity
- 69.9% believe the *librarian should be responsible for teaching* digcit either alone or in collaboration with teachers.

## BE INTERNET SMART

## Share with Care

Good (and bad) news travels fast online, and without some forethought, kids can find themselves in tricky situations that have lasting consequences. The solve? Learning how to share with those they know and those they don't.

**Communicate Responsibly**

- ✓ Encourage thoughtful sharing by treating online communication like face-to-face communication; if it isn't right to say, it isn't right to post.
- ✓ Create guidelines about what kind of communication is (and isn't) appropriate.
- ✓ Keep personal details about family and friends private.

## Don't Fall for Fake

It's important to help kids become aware that people and situations online aren't always as they seem. Discerning between what's real and what's fake is a very real lesson in online safety.

## Secure Your Secrets

## FUTURE READY LIBRARIAN SUPPORT STUDENT-CENTERED LEARNING

### LITERACY

#### Inspires and supports the reading lives of both students and teachers

Creates inclusive collections that acknowledge and celebrate diverse experiences and provide instructional opportunities to empower learners as effective users and creators of information and ideas.

### CURRICULUM, INSTRUCTION, AND ASSESSMENT

#### Curates Digital Resources

Leads in the selection, integration, organization, and sharing of digital resources and tools to support transformational teaching and learning and develops the digital curation skills of others.

#### Builds Instructional Partnerships

Partners with educators to design and implement evidence-based curricula and assessments that integrate elements of deeper learning, critical thinking, information literacy, digital citizenship, creativity, innovation, and the active use of technology.

#### Empowers Students as Creators

Encourages and facilitates students to become increasingly self-directed as they create digital products of their learning that engage them in critical thinking, collaboration, and authentic real-world problem solving.

### PERSONALIZED PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

#### Facilitates Personalized Professional Learning

Leads professional learning to cultivate broader understanding of the skills that comprise success in a digital age (e.g., critical thinking, information literacy, digital citizenship, technology).

### ROBUST INFRASTRUCTURE

#### Ensures Equitable Digital Access

Provides and advocates for equitable access to collection tools using digital resources, programming, and services in support of the school district's strategic vision.



### BUDGET AND RESOURCES

#### Invests Strategically in Digital Resources

Leverages an understanding of school and community needs to identify and invest in digital resources such as books and ebooks to support student learning.

#### Leads Beyond the Library

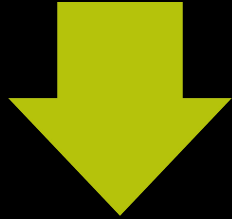
Participates in setting the school district's vision and strategic plan for digital learning and fosters a culture of collaboration and innovation to empower teachers and learners.
